## Our History

Our children spend only 20% of their time in school. How and where they spend the remaining 80% has profound implications for their well being and future. Project MOST was created by the East Hampton Day Care Center, the Town of East Hampton and the East Hampton Union Free School District to provide children at the John M. Marshall School engaging learning activities in a safe supportive environment in the critical hours after school. Project Most is in the final year of a grant by the NYS Office of Children and Family Services. Sustaining Project MOST will depend on the help of private donations.
